Dear Parents/Guardians and Seniors:

This year we will have over 240 new seniors and approximately 70 parking spots on campus for our students. To ensure fairness for all, there will be two senior parking lotteries: one in September and one in January to provide two sets of students with parking permits.

Please note that access to the senior lot is subject to change due to construction on the adjacent athletic fields.

In order to be eligible, students and parents/guardians **must** attend our *Driver Safety Program* and submit their completed application by 2:00 pm on the date of the lottery. The outcome of the lottery will provide students in September with permits that will expire in January. All students who have attended the fall program and submitted an application are automatically entered into our second offering for new permits in January.

The *Driver Safety Program* will offer information regarding campus parking by the high school administration. The Association for Community Parent Center Inc. will present "Driving in the Safe Lane" which includes valuable safety advice for parents/guardians and teens.

All students who would like to enter the lottery to receive a parking permit for the 2017-2018 school year **must** attend one of these two evening presentations **with a parent/guardian**, even if you do not yet have your license. Parking applications will be furnished at this event and applications will not be distributed at any other time.
